NOTES FROM THE SCHOOL NURSE

- 2) A medication authorization/administration form, available from the school office, must accompany the medication and must be completed and signed by a parent/guardian and the health care provider (physician, dentist, or nurse practitioner).
- 3) All medications must be kept in the original container, prescription medication must be in a pharmacy bottle labeled correctly with the dosage and times to give matching the physician's order on this form. The student's name must be on the bottle.
